FAQ's

1. How does LUANAR define an international student?

These are students who are neither citizens nor permanent residents of Malawi

2. Can the application fee be waived for international students?

No. every students is mandated to pay initial application fee and they're no exceptions

3. How do i know about accommodation at LUANAR?

Accommodation is a very crucial aspect in international student admission. Through the international Desk, international students can get all the information they need on accommodation. The international desk work hand in hand with the Director of students affairs to ensure timely assistance for students enquiring about accommodation.

4. How can I find information about programs offered at LUANAR?

Information can be accessed via our website or you can contact the international desk for further clarification

5. Can international students apply for an undergraduate degree?

LUANAR hosts both post-graduate and undergraduate students

6. Can international students apply for financial aid and scholarships?

Very limited scholarship opportunities are available at the moment at the university for international students.

7. What should I do to get a student a visa?

VISA application is done online but LUANAR provide the student with an admission letter to be used as proof of reason for visiting Malawi.

8. Do I need to submit my medical and police record?

Medical and criminal report are needed as a precondition for VISA and permit application.

9. Do I need health insurance?

Students do no need a health insurance rather the medical expenses are included in the tuition fees. All students are expected to apply for a university medical cover scheme shortly after they arrive on campus

10. Do I have to attend International Student Orientation?

All students are mandated to participate in orientation.
